



RULES FOR PLAYING MONEY GAME

1. Money Game shall be played on a layout mat which is marked in a manner similar to that shown in the diagram.

2. The game shall be played with two identical dice with the faces marked with the numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6.
3. The game shall be controlled by a dealer who is not permitted to wager.
4. No person other than the dealer shall throw the dice or activate the dice cage.
5. If any of the two dice fail to come to rest with one surface flat to the base of the dice cage or flat on the layout mat the dealer shall call "No Spin/Throw".
6. If the dealer calls "No Spin/Throw" all wagers shall be void on that spin/throw.
7. The minimum and maximum wagers shall be prominently displayed on a sign at the table.
8. A wager on a particular area shall win if the cumulative total of the uppermost surface of the two dice is:-
 - (i) the number displayed in the area wagered; or
 - (ii) any one of the numbers displayed in the area wagered.
9. The dollar value depicted in a particular area indicates the odds payable for a winning wager on that area.
10. Winning wagers shall be paid at odds not less than:-

if the cumulative total of the uppermost surface of the 2 dice is 11	10 to 1
if the cumulative total of the uppermost surface of the 2 dice is either 6 or 8	5 to 1
if the cumulative total of the uppermost surface of the 2 dice is either 5 or 7	2 to 1
if the cumulative total of the uppermost surfaces of the 2 dice is either 2, 3, 4, 9, 10 or 12	1 to 1

11. A person under the age of 18 years shall not participate in the game or be involved in the dealing or conduct of the game.
